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Conditions of Entry:

1. The competition will be conducted under EFA rules
2. BEG reserves the right to restrict classes to 25 with BEG members given priority
3. No phone nominations or late entries will be accepted after closing date (20% may be retained for admin costs)
4. Competitors requiring results posted must provide a stamped addressed envelope on the day
5. Entries not accepted unless rider completes waiver on back of form
6. All riders in associate classes must be Associate or Full members of the EFA &/or Brookfield Equestrian Group member
7. All members must be prepared to help for at least 2 hours or provide a helper
8. Children under the age of 17 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian
9. No dogs allowed on grounds
10. The organizing committee will determine the prize money or goods in kind in accordance with the entries for all official events
11. The ground fee has been charged due to the fees required to hire the grounds.
12. There is no postage fee for the draw. If you require a hard copy please include a stamped addressed envelope otherwise the draw will be posted on dressageit or e-mailed to you
13. Horses not entered in the event will not be permitted in the warm up area during the course of the event
14. Correct riding attire (boots, safety standards approved helmet and gloves must be worn whilst mounted upon a horse
15. Lungeing is only to be conducted at the rear of the warm up area. Horses must be lunged in a manner that does not disrupt or endanger other horses, competitors or spectators.
16. BEG events are run to a timed draw. Associate riders must be available to ride 30 mins before allocated time. Each competitor must be aware of ride time and report to gear check up to 15mins ahead of their stated time.
17. Competitors must report to gear check prior to each test
18. Riders are not permitted to mount their horses under the influence of drugs or alcohol
19. Public must not enter warm up area
20. Two bridle numbers must be worn for official classes
21. Champions are awarded to the horse/rider combination using a points system
22. To be eligible for championship riders must ride both tests for that level
